

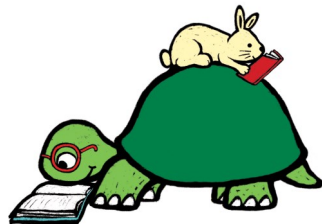

the Children's Room or at Curbside.

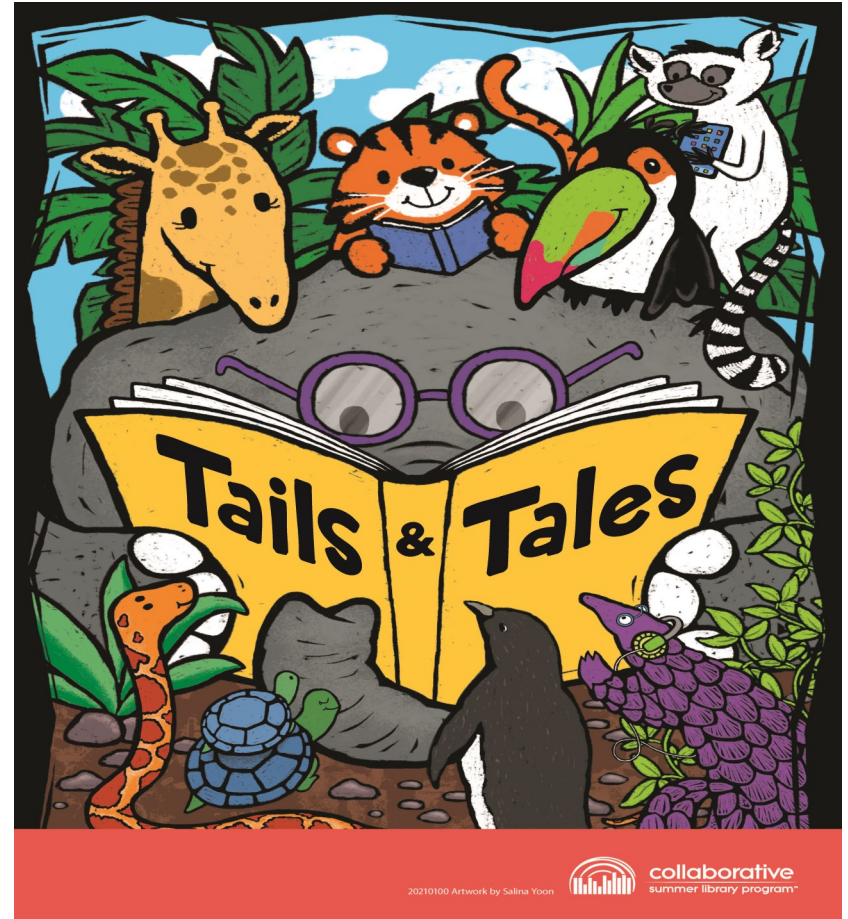
## Kindergarten Readiness—

Simple activities to prepare your preschooler for  
Kindergarten

- Check off items on a list of daily activities.
- Cross off days from a calendar.
- Play an alphabet search game. Choose a letter of the day and search for it on license plates, in stores, etc.
- Decorate an envelope or box and designate it the family “mailbox.” Family members can create letters and drawings and send them to each other.
- Practice tracing lines and letters.
- Practice cutting out shapes.
- Practice counting similar objects.
- Sing rhyming songs
- Draw pictures
- And of course, read favorite books every day!

## Summer Reading Program—

### Here's how the program works:

1. Registration begins Monday, June 14.
2. Register in the Children's Room OR Online at <https://westnyacklibrary.org/children.asp>
3. Once you've registered you can pick up a Summer Reading kit (including a reading log) in the library in person or at curbside. You can download additional reading logs from our website.
4. Start reading and logging your books.
5. Starting June 28, bring your log to the library OR email it to us each week to receive that week's prize for your reading. You can receive your prize in person or at curbside. Our email address is [wnykids@westnyacklibrary.org](mailto:wnykids@westnyacklibrary.org)
6. If you miss a week/weeks for any reason, that's okay—just keep reading and logging your books. When are able, come to the library, show us your logs with the titles and dates read and receive the prizes for those weeks.
7. Pre-K through Grade 1, list the date read and the titles of your books on the log.
8. Grade 2 and Up, list the title and dates read OR the amount of time on each date that you read the book.
