

West Nyack Free Library Roku Lending Policy

Borrowing and Use:

- The Roku may be borrowed by patrons ages 18 and older who have a valid West Nyack or New City library card. The loan period is 7 days.
- Holds may not be placed on the Roku through the library catalog. However, Patrons may call to request that the Roku be held for up to one hour if it is checked in at the time. There are no renewals.
- The Borrower may not tamper with the device's hardware, software or settings. The fine for tampering with the Roku's software is the full replacement cost of \$200. If any of the accessories are lost or damaged, the Patron will be charged the full replacement cost of the accessory.
- The Roku box contains 6 items: the Roku, the Roku remote, HDMI cable, A/V cable, the power cord and the Get Started Guide.

Fines and Liability:

- The Roku must be returned to the West Nyack Circulation desk only. It must be handed to a West Nyack staff member during library operating hours. The fine for returning the Roku in the bookdrop or to another library is \$25. Any loss incurred as the result of failed returns will be the responsibility of the Borrower.
- Overdue fines for the Roku are \$10 per day.
- The maximum late fee is \$50.
- If the Roku is more than 20 days overdue, the Library will assume the device is lost and the borrower will be responsible for the full replacement cost of \$200.
- Non-payment of fines will result in the loss of borrowing privileges in all RCLS libraries until all charges are resolved.
