A story of two people who come together in an unexpected way. Tiffy and Leon make an unusual agreement to share a flat (and bed!) without ever meeting. Tiffy has the apartment in the evenings while Leon works. When she is off to work, Leon comes home. They get to know each other through passing notes.

At first, I thought “The Flatshare” was only going to be a lighthearted romance. However, there are secondary themes that speak of more serious issues such as emotional abuse and miscarriage of justice. Also lending to this story is a cast of characters - ex-partners, friends and colleagues – that give you reason to care about them and root for Tiffy and Leon.
