## **Welcome to Winter Book Bingo.**

### **Here are the rules for your Bingo card—**

- **This Bingo Card is for Kids between the ages of 2 & 7. There's a separate Bingo card for kids ages 8-12.**
- **Each time you read a book, or have a book read to you that fulfills one of the squares, let a librarian know and she'll initial the square.**
- **Once you've completed BINGO! by filling in a row of five books (diagonally, horizontally or vertically) you get a prize.**
- **Each space represents a separate book. You cannot use the same book to fill more than one square.**
- **If you want to continue playing, you can get another prize for filling in your entire Bingo card.**
- **Make sure you keep your Bingo card in a special place because every child registered in Winter Book Bingo gets only one card.**
- **Remember to ask a librarian if you need help finding books that can complete a square.**
